# *Cinderella and Sleeping Beauty*

**WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP** – Washington Township's Town Hall Theatre is hosting two of literature's most beloved princesses as it closes its 2010-2011 season this May! The All Children's Theatre presents *Disney's Cinderella* and *Disney's Sleeping Beauty* as a double-feature **May 6-23, 2010**.

A scullery maid and a royal princess each experience very different adventures but each finds true love waiting at the end, when *Disney's Cinderella and Sleeping Beauty* opens **Thursday, May 6<sup>th</sup> with a special 4:30pm matinee** with additional shows on **Fridays at 7pm and on Saturdays and Sundays at 3pm**. *There are also 4:30pm matinees on Thursday, May 13<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup>.*

Town Hall Theatre is located at 27 North Main Street in the "Heart of Centerville", directly beside Panera Bread. **Tickets are \$10 for adults, \$8 for students and seniors and \$6 for children 12 & under. The show runs 70 minutes and is **recommended for children ages 2 and up**.

Two of Disney's most timeless stories come to life in this double-bill. First, Cinderella is endlessly mistreated by her wicked step-family and denied a chance to attend the Royal Ball. But, with a little help from her Fairy Godmother, not only does she go to the ball, but falls in love with the Prince!

Then, while her 16th birthday should be cause for Aurora's celebration, the evil Sorceress Maleficent

has got some very unsavory plans for this beauty! It's up to Flora, Fauna and Merriweather to use their fairy magic to save her from a terrible spell! Both shows are based on the cartoons created by Walt Disney.

The 60 person cast features **Maia Marnell**, who attends Magsig Middle School in Centerville as *Cinderella* and **Carly Marten**, who attends Incarnation in Centerville as *Sleeping Beauty*. Both stories feature wonderful villains, with Bellbrook native **Abby Knupp** as the wicked Stepmother, joined by her dispicable daughters played by **Colleen Kochensparger** and **Adele Taylor** of Centerville, while Centerville High School student **Kelli Hickey** is frightfully menacing as *Maleficent* in *Sleeping Beauty!* Brothers **Andrew** and **Matthew Perkins**, who play *Prince Charming* and *Prince Phillip*, respectively, both are Springboro residents.

The production is presented by the All Children's Theatre, the theatre's all youth shows featuring performers in grades 2-12. It is directed by **Colin Thornton**. The show features a set design by **Tamara Honesty** and **Justin Barisonek**, lighting by **Ryan Bochnowski**, sound by **Greg Dastillung** and costumes by **Briley Lambert**. **Anita Jackson** stage manages the show.
